(a) whether the Government have received any proposal from the State Government to provide/release financial assistance to Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) engaged in implementation of AIDS programmes during the last three years; and

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A. RAJA)

(a) & (b): Non Government Organisations engaged in implementation of AIDS programme aredirectly funded by State AIDSControl Societies except for proposals of Community Care Centers. From 1st April 2001 Community Care Centers are directly sanctioned to NGOsby State AIDS ControlSocieties in the six high prevalence states namely Karnataka, Manipur, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Nagaland. In other states proposals are submitted by NGOsto NACOthrough State AIDSControl Societies for approval.

The proposals received & sanctioned by NACO during the last three years are annexed.
