- (b) whether a number of fishermen are still languishing in Pak jails;
- (c) if so, since when they are in Pak captivity;
- (d) the succour being provided to the families of such fishermen; and
- (e) the efforts being made to secure their release?

(a)to(e) 22 Indian fishermen were repatriated to India on April 23, 2000 following their release on the night of April 22-23, 2000.

According to available information, 112 Indian fishermen are held in Pakistani custody. These fishermen were apprehended by the Pakistani Maritime Security Agency during the period October, 1999 to January, 2000.

Government is in continuous contact with Pakistan through diplomatic channels for securing the earliest release and repatriation of these fishermen.
