(b) if so, the reasons therefor and the steps taken to redress their grievances?

(a) & (b): According to the information furnished by the University of Delhi, the students in the School of Correspondence and Continuing Education held demonstration on 13th November, 2002 against the limited hours of public dealings in the School during the period of strike call given by the Delhi University and College Karamcharies Union.

The School of Correspondence and Continuing Education has since taken remedial measures to redress the grievances of the students by accepting the forms till 5.00 P.M. on a working day.
