Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have taken action to remove all the discriminations between A.H. Wheeler & Co. and the other bookstall contractors on all the Indian Railways; and
- (b) the quota fixed for allotment of bookstalls at Railway Stations for the weaker section of the society?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

- (a): Since the terms and conditions of the bookstall licence of M/s A . H . Wheeler & Co. vis-Ã -visother bookstall contractors are different, the question of discrimination does not arise.
- (b): As per policy, bookstall licences are awarded to
- (i) Cooperative societies of actual workers/vendors and cooperative societies of unemployed graduates;
- (ii) Partnerships and Associations of Unemployed graduates;
- (iii) Individual unemployed graduates who are sons/wards of railway men (existing or retired)
- (iv) Individual unemployed graduates other than those mentioned at
- (iii) above. No special quota for weaker section of the society has been prescribed in the allotment of bookstalls.
