## Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Foreign Minister of France visited India in July-August, 2002 and held discussion on Indo-French co-operation in the political, economic, military, scientific and cultural fields and reviewed the strategic dialogue initiated between the two countries in 1998;
- (b) if so, whether any agreements between the two countries on that occasion had been signed;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the extent to which these agreements are likely to boost Indo-French ties?

## **Answer**

- a) French Foreign Minister Dominique de Villepin visited India on 2nd-3rd August 2002. During his meeting with EAM a wide range of issues were discussed including an in depth review of bilateral political, economic, scientific and cultural cooperation as well as regional and international issues of mutual concern. The on-going strategic dialogue between the two countries was also reviewed.
