STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 93 FOR 24.2.2000.

The security situation in J&K has been constantly reviewed and various steps for curbing militancy and terrorism in J&K have been undertaken with a view to check infiltration across the Line of Control more effectively, improve the internal security situation and ensure better coordination among various agencies involved and the speedy execution of developmental projects in the State. The army has enhanced its vigil along the Line of Control and Actual Ground Position Line. Suitably composed forces have also been earmarked and kept ready to be able to react quickly to any misadventure which Pakistan may undertake.
