## **Answer**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (PROF. RITA VERMA)

(a): Ministries of Social Justice & Empowerment and Tribal Affairs are already implementing the schemes of hostels for SC/STboys and girls studying in middle, high and senior secondary schools, colleges and universities. Central assistance is provided to State Governments on matching share basis and 100% to UTs.

Ministry of Human Resource Development accords priority to theareas of concentration of SCs and STs in its scheme of strengthening of boarding and hostel facilities for girl students of Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools.

- (b): Yes, 'Sir'.
- (c) & (d): Four Hon'ble Members of Parliament (MPs)have applied for Grant-in-Aid during the years 2000-2001,2001- 2002 and 2002-2003 (up till now) under the scheme implemented by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs and have availed the grants for Rs.89.82 lakhs.
