- (a) whether the basic phone operators have requested to reduce the call duration from three minutes to 1 1/2 minutes;
- (b) whether the operators have also requested to have two slabs for rentals;
- (c) if so, the details in this regard; and
- (d) the reaction of the Government thereto?
