- (a) the projects started in Orissa with Japanese aid and assistance;
- (b) the amount of Japanese aid and assistance obtained for implementing those projects so far;
- (c) the progress of those projects; and
- (d) the amount utilized for those projects so far?

(a) to (d): Two projects, namely, the Rengali Irrigation Project (State sector) and Improvement of NH-5 (Central sector) in the State of Orissa are under implementation with assistance from Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC). The loanagreement for Rengali Irrigation Project was signed on 12.12.1997 for an amount of Japanese Yen 7,760 million. The loan agreement for NH-5 improvement, Orissa was signed on 28.2.1995 for an amount of JY 5836 million. An amount of JY 3620 million in respect of the Rengali Irrigation Project and JY 1284 million in respect of NH-5Improvement Project, Orissa have been utilized by the concerned Project Implementing authorities as on 31.3.2002.
