**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government are aware that the condition of National Highway No.22 from Dhalli to Rampur is very dilapidated;
- (b) if so, whether any survey has been conducted in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) if not, the reasons thereof?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS [MAJOR GENERAL (RETD KHANDUR)]

- (a) to (c) The section of National Highway No.22 between Dhalli to Rampur is in traffic-worthy condition. Its survey and maintenance is a continuing process.
- (d) In the stretch between Dhalli to Rampur in 31 Km. of length widening, in 10 km improvement of riding quality and in 77 km periodical renewal works have been sanctioned.
