(a) to (e) A number of proposals for providing Family Welfare and Primary Health Care Services were received from various States. While the projects for urban health programme are funded by this Ministry, the other area projects are supported by foreign agencies like UNFPA, DFID (UK),DANIDA (Denmark), Government of Germany etcA statement showing the project proposals received from various states under the urban health programme and other Area Projects along with their details and present status is at Annexure - I.

Besides, 24 States of the country are supported under European Commission assisted Sector Investment Programme (SIP)The outlays have been earmarked for each State and the proposals received from the States are scrutinized and funds are released there from. Details of funds released under this programme during the last three years are given at Annexure - II. The details of the proposals received from States for foreign assistance are given at Annexure - III.
