(a) whether in October, 2002 the Government had decided to ban certain drugs which were declared unsafe;

(b) if so, whether the Government instead of banning the same extended the deadline for their circulation upto August 1, 2003; and

(c) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A. RAJA)

(a) to (c) The Drugs formulations of Terfinadine and Astemizole for human use were earlier prohibited for manufacture, sale and distribution with effect from lst August, 2003 through a Gazette Notification GSR 732(E) dated 29.10.2002. The mater has been further reviewed and the manufacture of these drugs formulation is now being prohibited with immediate effect and their sale and distribution with effect from lst April, 2003.
