Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any funds of CAPART have become Non-performing asset;
- (b) if so, whether any assessment has been made on the state of funds loaned to NGOs;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the proportion of such funds that have become irretrievable;
- (e) whether any steps have been taken to ensure that funds of CAPART are properly spent all over the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI U. V. KRISHNAM RAJU)

- (a) to (c) No, Sir. CAPART provides assistance in the form of grants to NGOs forprojects. Periodic evaluation of the utilization of these grants is done to ensure their proper utilisation.
- (d) Question does not arise.
- (e) &(f) Yes, Sir. CAPART has taken steps to ensure that funds are properlyspent/utilised all over the country by the NGOs.Since 1997, CAPART has instituted a 3- tier system of monitoring by the independent monitors consisting of,
- (i) pre-funding appraisal (before consideration/sanction of a project proposal).
- (ii) mid-term evaluation (after release of 1st instalment and before subsequent release of funds).
- (iii) post evaluation (after completion of the project).

Besides in some cases, Comprehensive evaluation is also carried out when CAPART receives any complaint against a Voluntary Organisation regarding misutilization of funds.
