Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of major and medium irrigation projects in the country which are still incomplete;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, project-wise and State- wise;
- (c) whether several projects are running behind their time schedule;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor, project-wise;
- (e) the present status of each such project and the total amount spent thereon so far;
- (f) the estimated irrigation capacity likely to be achieved after completion of these projects; and (g) the time by which these projects are likely to be completed?

(a) to (g) Irrigation being a State subject, Irrigation projects are taken-up for implementation by the State Governments themselves out of their own resources and as per their own priorities. The normal completion period is 10-15 years in respect of major projects and 5-10 years in respect of medium irrigation projects. The completion period of any project depends on various factors such as its size, availability of land, obtaining clearances from various central appraising agencies by the State Governments, geological conditions etc. The equally important are the funds allotted by the State Governments to the individual projects. State-wise details of 155 Major and 234 medium irrigation projects which are at present under execution along-with their present status, total amount spent thereon and the estimated irrigation capacity likely to be achieved after their completion is given in the Statement enclosed.
