**Will the Minister of INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the USA has relaxed controls on import of hi-tech computers from India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government have made any plan to tap the US market particularly in this sector; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) and (b): With effect from 23rd January, 2000 the US Government has increased the (Composite Theoretical Performance (CTP) rating computers (which can be exported to India from USA) from 7000 to 12300 MTOPS (Million Theoretical Operations Per Second) for civilian applications and from 2000 to 6500 MTOPS for military applications.

(c) and (d): In order to exploit markets/customers in US, Far East and Europe for promoting advanced computing solutions in areas such as Power Telecom, Finance/Capital Market, Health and other Government sectors, Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC) have proposed to set up an overseas office in USA.
