- (a) and (b): With effect from 23rd January, 2000 the US Governmenthas increased the (Composite Theoretical Performance (CTP) rating computers (which can be exported to Indian from USA) from 7000 to12300 MTOPS (Million Theoretical Operations Per Second) for civilian applications and from 2000 to 6500 MTOPS for military applications.
- (c) and (d): In order to exploit markets/customers in US, Far Eastand Europe for promoting advanced computing solutions in areas such as Power Telecom, Finance/Capital Market, Health andother Government sectors, Centre for Development of Advanced Computing(C-DAC) have proposed to set up an overseas office in USA.
