- (a) & (b): A list of major Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes underimplementation for the promotion and development of agriculture sector in the State of Maharashtra is as follows:
- 1. Macro Management Scheme
- 2. Technology Mission on Cotton
- 3. Oilseed Production Programme
- 4. National Pulses Development Project
- 5. Accelerated Maize Development Programme
- 6. Investment in Debentures of Land Development Banks
- 7 National Project on Development and Use of Bio-fertilizers.
- (c): The benefit of the Schemes implemented by the Government of India are extended to allcategory of farmers including small and marginal farmers. These Schemes provide assistance invarious components and some of the components give special consideration to certain category of farmers such as small and marginal farmers. The Government also implement Schemes forprice and market support which help in strengthening the farm income and economic conditions of the farmers. These Schemes cover all categories of farmers including small and marginal farmers.
