## THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI ARJUN CHARAN SETHI)

- (a) & (b) The 19th Annual General Meeting of National Water Development Agency (NWDA) Society was held on 26thMarch, 2003. Shri Arjun Charan Sethi, Hon'ble Minister of Water Resources and President, NWDASociety presided over the meeting. Shri T.M. Jacob, Minister of Water Resources, Government of Kerala attended themeeting. Representatives from States of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Kerala, Tamil Nadu & Uttar Pradesh participated in the meeting. The agenda items related to progress of work done by NWDA duringthe year 2002-2003 (upto December, 2002), Constitution of Task Force on Interlinking of Rivers, Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC)Memo for continuation of NWDA during 10th Five Year Plan (2002-07) etc.. After deliberations & discussions, the Society noted/approved the Agenda items placed before the meeting.

- (d) & (e) As per the programme drawn up by Central Government, implementation of the project of Inter-linking of rivers is scheduled for completion by 31.12.2016.
