(a) to (d): Filling up of vacant posts is governed by the Central Government instructions contained in DOPT OMNo.2/8/2001-PIC dated 16.5.2001. As far as vacant posts of Nurses in Central Government Hospitals in Delhi are concerned, the Screening Committee has already approved filling up thereof.
