- (a) and (b): Yes Sir. The Planning Commission has set up an internal Standing Group on Economic Fallout of Iraq War comprising of Planning Commission officials for assessing the impact of the Iraq War on the Indian economy, particularly on exports, inward remittances, oil prices and tourism.
