- (a) whether Railways has received a credit of Rs.50 crore from Spain to undertake a survey and prepare the feasibility report for introduction of bullet train services in the 550 km. stretch between Mumbai and Ahmedabad:

- (c) whether the Railways has examined the said proposal;
- (d) if so, the manner in which the said amount is likely to be utilized; and
- (e) the time by which the survey and feasibility report is likely to be prepared?

(a) to (e): Ministry of Railways has not received any credit from Spain. However, an MOU has been signed between the Indian Railways and the Spanish Railways (RENFE) agreeing in principle for a techno- economideasibility study for running of a Highspeed train services for a nominated corridor to be funded by the Spanish Government.

Ministry of Finance and Ministry of External Affairs havebeen approached by this Ministry for processing the proposal further through the Spanish Emabasy at Delhi.
