However, a project proposal was received from Haryana State Women's Development Corporation, Chandigarh under the scheme of Setting up of Employment-cum- Income Generating Units for Women (NORAD).It has been approved for 840 beneficiaries in the trades of handloom weaving and beauty culture training programmes with cost estimates of Rs.22,65,600/- (Rupees Twenty two lakhs sixty five thousand six hundred only).
