(a) to (c) The disinvestment structure envisages handing over Samrat Hotel, New Delhi on long-term Lease-cum-Management Contract basis through competitive bidding process. Advertisement inviting Expressions of Interest for the hotel was issued on 5/8.2.2001. Financial bids were not invited due to security related concerns. It was decided in March 2002 that advertisement for this hotel may be issued after addressing the security related concerns in consultation with the security agencies. The process is on.
