(a) whether the Indian Navy is likely to get 'Krivak' version of warship from Russia in June this year;

- (b) if so, whether some technical snags have been found therein;
- (c) if so, whether these snags have been rectified; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES)

(a) Subject to successful trials in Russia such a warship is expected in May this year.

(b) All systems are satisfactory except for one weapon system.

(c) The deficiency has not been rectified as yet.

(d) Rectification would depend upon proper analysis of test data and determination of corrective measures, an exercise for which is underway.
