- (a) New projects numbering 54 in Maharashtra, 32 in Rajasthan, 20 each in Kerala and Uttar Pradesh and 42 in Andhra Pradesh were sanctioned.
- (b),(c)&(d) During the period of project formulation, all the projects in Karnataka were covered under General ICDS. Assuch, Karnataka was not taken under World Bank assisted ICDS-III Project.
