(a)to (c): As per the current policy, telephone directories are printed either on positive royalty or negative royalty depending upon the offers received. There have been cases of non-printing of directories on account of default by the contractors, non-availability of contractors and legal cases. Action is taken against defaulters as per departmental rules.
