Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) the transmission and distribution loss of each of the State Electricity Boards/States during each of the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) the transmission and distribution loss before the reform is undertaken in the concerned States and after that, State-wise and year-wise:
- (c) the steps are being taken to reduce huge T&D loss of SEBs/Companies/States;
- (d) whether any survey has been conducted regarding the theft of electricity; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof Sector-wise and State-wise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRIMATI JAYAWANTI MEHTA)

- (a) : A statement indicating the year-wise and State-wise Transmission & Distribution losses from 1997-98 to 1999-2000 is given in the Annexure.
- (b): Distribution reforms in the form of Accelerated Power DevelopmentProgramme (APDP) now rechristened as Accelerated Power Development and ReformsProgramme (APDRP), was launched only in February, 2001. The State-wise/year wise transmission and distribution loss after the reforms were undertaken in the concerned States can be assessed only after the audited figures upto the year 2001-02 are made available by the State Electricity Boards/Utilities.
- (c): In order to upgrade the sub-transmission and distribution network with the objective of accomplishing reduction of transmission and distribution (technical and commercial) losses, reduction in cash losses by State Electricity Boards/Utilities and supply of reliable and interruption free power, the Government of India introduced the APDRP.APDRP includes up gradation of sub-transmission and distribution network, energy audit activities and metering in a phased manner.
