- (d) the additional power to be generated after expansion?

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b) to (d): Expansion Unit-8 at Raichur Thermal Power Plant has been planned to beimplemented in 10th Plan period. The cost of the expansion of Unit-8 is estimated at Rs.664.66 crores including interest during construction. 210 MW of additional installed capacity with an annual energy of 1416 million units are proposed to be generated from the expansion Unit.
