(c) the amount spent by the ONGC foundations in the protection of ancient monuments and the details thereof?

(a) Neither the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas nor any Oil PSUs under the administrative control of this Ministry allocates any amount of SCP to any State Government. However, the Oil PSUs undertake various types ofactivities on their own for the socioeconomic development of weaker sections of the society residing in the neighbourhood of their respective project - locations in different states.

(c) There is no such specific fund earmarked by ONGC for the protection of ancient monuments.
