(c) & (d): The Planning Commission constituted a `Special Group on Targeting 10 MillionEmployment Opportunities Per Year` under the Chairmanship of Member (Labour, Employment & Manpower), Planning Commission, which examined the recommendations of the Task Force on Employment Opportunities, in detail, and gave its recommendations. Employment Perspective for the Tenth Five Year Plan (2002-07) was prepared on the basis of these recommendations.
