- (a) whether the Government propose to construct new airports in Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total number of airports in operations in the State at present?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) & (b) Airports Authority of India(AAI) has no plan atpresent to construct new Airports in the State of Maharashtra. However, State Government of Maharashtra has proposal to construct a second airport at Navi Mumbai. The City and Industrial Development Corporation (CIDCO) of Maharashtra prepared the techno-economic feasibility report for a second international airport at Navi Mumbai and they have been asked to identify the required land for two parallel runways since the runways must be capable of handling simultaneous operations.
- (c) There are five airports, including one Civil Enclave at Pune, in operation under Airports Authority of India at present, in the State of Maharashtra.
