- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether APCPDCL have cancelled the orders mid-way placed on BHEL and other firms; and
- (d) if so, the action taken by the REC and PFC to prevail upon APCPDCL for the estoration and completion of orders placed on BHEL and others and the reaction of the APCPDCL thereto?
