STATEMENT IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTIONS NO. 63 DUE FOR REPLY ON 29TH FEBRUARY, AMDIED BY SHRI AMAR ROYPRADHAN, MP REGARDING ELECTRIFICATION OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR BORDER FENCING.

A multi-modal approach for sealing the Jammu Internetional Border has been planned which comprises of fencing/lighting/Intruder Alarm System at an estimated cost of Rs. 23 crores. This is being proposed with a view of prevent infiltration from across the border. Decision to start this work will be taken an an appropriate time.

Electrification of the International border in Punjab and Rajashthan has been completed, except for some riverine gaps/sand dune areas respectively. Similarly work in the Gujarat sector has already been started and would be completed in about 5 years time. There is no proposal to electrify and international border at present.
