SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY PARKS IN JHARKHAND

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to set up electronic Software Technology Parks in Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details of the districts alongwith the locations for which assistance has been provided by the Government for setting up such parks; and
- (c) the details of the guidelines issued for the setting up of electronic software parks?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY(SU THIRUNAVUKKARASAR)

(a) and (b): A proposal to set up a Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) Centre at Ranchi, Jharkhand has already been approved. A project proposal for setting up of HSDC facility and incubation Centre at Ranch was approved by Ministry of Commerce and Industry for funding of Rs 3.5 Crores under their scheme 'Assistance to States for Developing Export Infrastructure and Allied Activities (ASIDE)'. In addition Department of Information Technology, has also released a grant-in-aid of Rs 50 lakhs. The State Government will also provide 3 acres of land and 3000 sq.ft of built up space.

(c): The setting up of new centre is based on export potential as well as the State Government's willingness to provide land, built up area and financial support.
