## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to set up electronic Software Technology Parks in Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details of the districts alongwith the locations for which assistance has been provided by the Government for setting up such parks; and
- (c) the details of the guidelines issued for the setting up of electronic software parks?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY(SU THIRUNAVUKKARASAR)

- (a) and (b): A proposal to set up a Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) Centre atRanchi, Jharkhand has already been approved. A project proposal for setting up of HSDC facility and incubation Centre at Ranch was approved by Ministry of Commerce and Industry for funding of Rs 3.5 Crores under their scheme `Assistance to States for Developing Export Infrastructure and Allied Activities (ASIDE)`. In addition Department of Information Technology, has also released a grant-in-aid of Rs 50 lakhs. The State Government will also provide 3 acres of land and 3000 sq.ft of built up space.
- (c): The setting up of new centre is based on export potential as well as the State Government's willingness to provide land, built up area and financial support.
