Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal to set up new telephone exchanges in the rural, tribal and remote areas of the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(c) the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon;

(d) whether the Government propose to link all the telephone exchanges having 1000 lines with optical fibre cable or microwave system in the country; and

(e) if so, by when all the exchanges are likely to be connected with OFC?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRIMATI S MAHAJAN)

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. As per the present policy, planning for the rural areas is preferred using WLL (Wirelessin Local Loop) systems. However, if WLL solution is not possible due to technical reason, new exchanges are planned with minimum registration of 75 with in the local area of the exchange. The details of the exchanges planned to be provided are given in the Annexure.

(c) The likely expenditure is about Rs. 183 Crores for WLL during the current year.

(d) Yes, Sir.

(e) Government has a policy to provide reliable media (OFC, Microwave system etc.) to all exchanges by the year 2003.
