- (a) whether the Government propose to open four new post offices in North-East Mumbai and reconstruct seven post offices in the same district;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) by when these post offices are likely to be setup/reconstructed?

(a) to (c): There is a proposal for opening four new post offices in North-East Mumbai, at Mhada Colony- Mulund, Hiranandani Gardens - Powai, Ramabai Nagar -Ghatkopar and Pratap Nagar Road (Hanuman Nagar) -Bhandup(West), subject to availability of requisite resources and of suitable accommodation on rent. There is no proposal to construct any Departmental building for these proposed post offices or to reconstruct any existing buildings in North-East Division, Mumbai.
