- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any of the block from Western Coalfields Limited has been chosen for development of CBM under this agreement;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF COAL (SHRI KARIYA MUNDA)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Two blocks have been awarded to CIL- ONGCconsortium on nomination basis. These two blocks are Raniganj (about 356 Sq. KM) in the state of West Bengal and another block at Jharia (about 85 Sq. KM)in the state of Jharkhand. Coal India Limited has signed a contract for the same along with ONGC with Government of India on 6/2/2003.
- (c): No, Sir.
- (d): Does not arise in view of reply given to part (c) above.
- (e): WCL blocks have not been considered for awarding to CIL-ONGC on nomination basis.
