(a) to (c) 11 District Rehabilitation Centres have been set up in 10 States in the districts of Bhiwani (Haryana), Bhubaneswar (Orissa), Bilaspur (Chhattisgarh), Chengalpattu (TamilNadu), Kota (Rajasthan), Jagdishpur (Uttar Pradesh), Sitapur (Uttar Pradesh), Virar (Thane District-Maharashtra), Midnapore (West Bengal), Mysore (Karnataka) and Vijayawada (Andhra Pradesh).

(d) Grants-in-aid released to the 11 DRCs during 2002-2003 is given as under:- Rs. in lakhs
