- (a) whether the Government have set up or propose to set up Regional RehabilitationCentres (RRCs) for persons with spinal injuries and orthopaedic disabilities;
- (b) if so, the cities at which these centres have been set up or proposed to be set up, State-wise;
- (c) whether there is any proposal to set up R.R.C. at Hyderabad;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the total money sanctioned and spent under the project?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE & EMPOWERMENT (DR. SANJAY PASWAN)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Four regional Rehabilitaton Centres (RRCs) for persons withspinal injuries and orthopaedic disabilities are approved to be set up at Mohali (Pnjab), Bareilly (Uttar Pradesh), Cuttack (Orissa) and Jabalpur (Madhya Pradesh).
- (c) No, Sir.
- (d) Does not arise.
- (e) A total amount of Rs.9.35 crores has been released for the RRCs so far.
