SEALING OF INDO-CHINA BORDER

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the States involved in the sealing of Indo-China Borders;
- (b) the assistance extended to those States to seal the border during the last three years, till date, year-wise and
- (c) the progress made in the direction and the time by which it is likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI I.D.SWAMI)

- (a): The States of Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttaranchal, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh share their borders with China. There is no proposal with the Government of India regarding sealing of the Indo-China Border. The integrity of this border is being maintained by regular patrolling etc. by the security forces.
