(b) whether the guidelines have been finalised in this regard;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the measures taken or proposed to be taken to ensure full proof transactions by these agencies ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SIKDAR)

(a) The Government has approved one proposal of domestic money transfer business as a fund based non-banking financial company activity, subject to compliance with regulatory framework and capitalisation norms, and exclusion of outward money transfer activity. The Government does not propose to allow travel agents and courier service providers to enter this business.

(b) to (d) Guidelines in this regard are to be finalised by Reserve Bank of India.
