(a) No, Sir. The Departmentis charging Rs. 1/- as money order commission for the transmission of every sum of Rs. 20/- or part thereof.

(b) Does not arise in view of (a) above.

(c) & (d): A major thrust to expedite transmission of money orders has been given by induction of satellite technology. 150 high speed Very Small Aperture Terminal (VSAT) stations linking 850 post offices in the country have been installed.
