## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of cellular subscribers in metropolitan cities viz Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore, Kolkata, Chennai& Hyderabad ason date, City-wise;

(b) whether there has been a fall in the number of cellular subscribers during the past few months;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) if not, the rate of increase in the number of cellular subscribers during the first six months of the current financial year in the above cities?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRIMATI S MAHAJAN)

(a) Sir, for Cellular Mobile Telephone Service (CMTS) Licences, thecountry is divided into 24 Service Areas consisting of 4 Metro City Service Areas (viz. Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Chennai) and 20 Telecom Circle Service Areas. A subscriber of CMTS belongs to the whole of Service Area and not to a particular place within the Service Area. Thus, a subscriber in Bangalore or Hyderabad would belong respectively to Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh Service Areas.

As per the information provided by Cellular Operators Association of India (COAI) on behalf of Cellular Operators, he number of CMTS subscribers as on 31.10.2002 in the six Service Areas are given in the Annexure.
