- (b) the funds allocated/spent on each of these schemes during each of the last three years, scheme-wise
- (c) whether attention of the Government have been drawn to the backward and most backward classes under these welfare schemes;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of families and people benefited under these schemes during each of the last three years in Rajasthan?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRIS. B. MOOKHERJEE)

- (a) The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment operates welfare schemes for Scheduled Castes/Minorities/Disabled and the Ministry of Tribal Affairs for Scheduled Tribes throughout the country and not for a particular State and not in particular districts.
- (b) No State-wise allocation is made under welfare schemes. During the last three years funds released under these schemes in Rajasthan are detailed in the statement at Annexure-I. State Governments and Voluntary Organizations are released grant only after utilization certificates have been received for the previous releases.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Sir. During Ninth Five Year Plan, the Ministry has launched schemes for educational and economic development of Other Backward Classes.
- (e) The number of persons/families benefited under these welfare schemes during the relevant period in the State is given in the statement at Annexure II.
