MULTI MODAL METRO TRANSPORT SYSTEM IN HYDERABAD

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether work on multi-modal Metro Transport System in Hyderabad is progressing very slowly;
- (b) if so, whether at some of the stations very little work has been done;
- (c) if so, the details and the reasons therefore; and
- (d) the time by which the train will start running on this system?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

(a) No, Sir.

(b) & (c) At two stations viz. 'Lakdi ka pool' where work has just started due to delayed acquisition of land by the State Govt., and at 'Neclace Road', work is delayed because of a Court case.

(d) All infrastructure works, except the two stations mentioned above, are likely to be completed by 31.03.2003. However, since this work is being executed on cost – sharing basis with the Government of Andhra Pradesh, target date for introduction of trains can be decided only in consultation with the State Govt.
