- (a) & (b): No, Sir. However, a token provision of Rs.100 crore has been made in the Union Budget for the year 2002-03 for revitalization of the co-operative credit structure in the country.
- (c) & (d): Though cooperation is a state subject but the Government of India hasbeen advising the State Governments from time to time for undertaking reform measures in cooperative sector for improving their performance and viability.
