MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

(a): No Sir. However, the National Agricultural Insurance Scheme (NAIS) providingcomprehensive risks coverage to yield losses arising due to non-preventable risks (i.e. all natural risks non-preventable in nature) is in operation in the country from Rabi 1999-2000 season. Since, losses to agricultural crops due to wild animals are preventable in nature, therefore, it is not covered under the existing scheme.
