- (a) whether the Government propose to introduce the rural and farm sector information technology such as providing on line information on modern farm practices, integrated pest management, curing and grading techniques, post-harvest product management and prices prevailing in global markets and at the auction centres to the farmers.
- (b) if so, the steps taken in this regard;
- (c) if not, the reasons therfor; and
- (d) the steps being taken/proposed to be taken to involve the NGO's and Self Help Groups to implement other innovative technologies to further speed up the growth of the rural farm sector?

- (a) to (c): To provide on line agricultural information to the farmers and agriculturists, the Ministry of Agricuture in collaboration with National Informatics Centre have initiated following programmes;
- (i) A NICNET based Agricultural Informatics and Communication Network (AGRISNET) onnecting the National, State and District Headquarters.
- (ii) Agricultural Marketing Information System (AGMARKNET) to facilitate generation antransmission of prices and arrivals information from agricultural produce markets.
- (iii) A Computerized Registration of Pesticides (CROP), a package for registration of pesticides and dissemination of Information to safeguard farmers against losses in crop production due to pests and diseases.
- (iv) Three Websites have been launched: (www.agricoop.nic.in, www.dare.nic.in, www.nic.in/dahd)

These websites are linked with other agricultural related institutions/organization State Agricultural Universities to provide comprehensive information on agriculture and allied sectors.

(d): The involvement of NGOs and Self Help Groups in dissemination of innovative technologieshave been proposed to accelerate public-private partnership in agriculture extension during Xth Plan.
