## Answer

(a) Yes, sir. The British Council and the British High Commission in India organized a Science Festival 2002 in important cities of India, from 7-18 January, 2002 which highlighted the best of British Science.

(b) As per the information received, the focus was on Biomedical research, Biotechnology, Digital Communication, and Environment where both the Uk and India have substantial strengths. As a part of the Festival, besides organization of a series of lectures, by visiting British Scientists in the indicated topics, the focus was also on organizing exhibitions and science education events in important cities.

(c) The Festival was organized in Chandigarh, New Delhi, Lucknow, Ahmedabad, Kolkatta, Mumbai, Pune, Hyderabad, Bangalore, Chennai and Thiruvananthapuram.

(d) Several eminent British and Indian Scientists participated in the festival with the objective of strengthening the India-Uk science and technology relationship. They contributed to panel discussions, public lectures and workshops on contemporary research and innovative ideas to promote scientific partnership and cooperation.
